

COMPETITION

for scholarships for full-time pupils and students
in the school/academic year 2013/14 from funds provided by the Fund "Bošnjaci"

I

In accordance with the Article 17 of the Statute the Main Board of the Fund "Bošnjaci" Sarajevo has brought a Decision about granting of **108 scholarships** to pupils and students in the school/academic year 2013/2014 as follows:

1. **20 (twenty) scholarships for high school students** (*proposed by schools in accordance with the criteria of the Fond "Bošnjaci"*):
 - a) The First Bosniak High School in Sarajevo..... 5 scholarships;
 - b) Gazi Husrev-bey madrassa in Sarajevo..... 5 scholarships;
 - c) Elchi Ibrahim-pasha madrassa in Travnik 2 scholarships;
 - d) Behram-bey madrassa in Tuzla 2 scholarships;
 - e) Karadoz-bey madrassa in Mostar..... 2 scholarships;
 - f) Madrassa "Osman ef. Redžović" in Visoko..... 2 scholarships;
 - g) Madrassa "Džemaludin ef. Čaušević" in Cazin..... 2 scholarships.
2. **Eighty eight (88) scholarships for students at public high level education institutions:**
 - a) **74 scholarships** to full time students at the first and second cycles of studies in accordance with criteria and scoring system;
 - b) **5 scholarships** to full time students of Faculty of Islamic Sciences in Sarajevo (*by FIS proposal in accordance with the criteria of the Fond "Bošnjaci"*).
 - c) **5 scholarships** to the students of the third cycles of studies (*current scholarship holders of the Fond "Bošnjaci" with an average grade of 10.00*);
 - d) **2 scholarships** to the pupil of generation of the First Bosniak Gymnasium in Sarajevo in school year 2013/2014 and
 - e) **2 scholarships** to the pupil of generation of Gazi Husrev-bey madrassa in Sarajevo in school year 2013/2014

II

Scholarships are granted for the academic/school 2013/14 year from September 01, 2013 till June 30, 2014 which are 10 scholarships in monthly amounts of:

- a) **120.00 KM** for high school pupils;
- b) **150.00 KM** for students of the first cycles of studies;
- c) **170.00 KM** for students at the first and second cycles of studies with an average grade of 10.00 and
- d) **200.00 KM** for students at the third cycles of studies with an average grade of 10.00.

III

GENERAL CRITERIA:

- a citizen of BiH;
- full time pupil in one of abovementioned schools;
- full time student at one of the **public** high level education institutions in Bosnia and Herzegovina;
- not older than 20 or 27 years.

IV

SPECIFIC CRITERIA:

- results achieved in learning and behavior;
- a pupil or a student of the first year of study (freshman) has to have the minimum grade point average of **4.50** in the final high school grade;
- a student has to have the minimum grade point average of **8.00** in the previous academic year;
- reported specific results at cantonal, federal, national and international competitions in mathematics, physics, information science and foreign languages for previous school/academic year in organization or by help of relevant ministry of education;
- financial resources of the family - social status;
- that the candidate does not receive scholarship from any other legal entity or an individual and does not receive financial compensation on any other basis;
- no more than one person from a family can get scholarship in school/academic 2013/2014 year.
- unconditional rights for a scholarship have full time students of the **first and second cycles** of the studies with grade point average of **10.00** regardless of the status of the high level education institution.

V

For the first year students (freshmen) grade point average and other criteria are taken from the final year of the high school, while for the first grade students of a high school grade point average is taken from the final year of the primary school.

VI

Commission for scoring and establishing of nominations for scholarships will determine the number of points for each candidate according to the following:

- points based on the results achieved in learning and competitions;
- points based on the average income per household member;
- points based on the social status of the candidate and family;
- points based on previous use of scholarship, etc.

REQUIRED DOCUMENTS:

a) General

- application for scholarship (*download from the web site www.fondbosnjaci.co.ba or take in the Fund headquarters*);
- certificate about regular enrolment in academic year 2013/14;
- a certified copy of index (*the page with personal data and photo*);
- copy of diploma and certificate of the final grade in the high school (*for students in the first year of study*);
- certificate of citizenship;
- household list (*issued and certified by the municipality*);
- statement of the applicant that he/she is not a scholar of the second legal entity or an individual (*statement given and certified in the municipality*).

b) Documents which are rated

- Certificate of having passed the exams from the previous year with an grade point average calculated to two decimal places;
- Evidence for students of the first year of studying that they were a pride or the pupil of the generation;
- Evidence for winning of the first, second or third place at cantonal, federal, national or international competition in mathematics, physics, information science and foreign languages for the previous school/academic year organized by or via competent ministry of education;
- Proof of total monthly revenue/income of all adult household members based on: employment, pension, self-employment, protection of war veterans and other sources (*pay list for the last month for employed, last pension check for retired persons, IMO and LIMO checks, assurance of Employment service for unemployed household members, and if they are not registered in Employment service they will provide assurance from PIO/MIO office that are not registered as insured persons based on employment or certified copy of the health insurance booklet from which one can see information about the insured person, insurance basis or relationship with the insured person, for household members under the age of six should be submitted a Birth Certificate*);
- a certificate which shows that no one of adult household members has own personal private business (*issued by the Tax Administration office in the municipality, Department of economy, budget and finance or municipal Department of economic development, etc.*);
- evidence for parents: a shahid family, without one or both parents (*Extract from the Register of deaths, participation in DL war for at least 24 months, evidence for wartime disability of parents – over 60 or 80%*);
- evidence about personal disabling of a candidate - over 60%;
- evidence for regular education of pupils/students in the family;

VII

The deadline for submission of applications is **October 23, 2013**.

VIII

The results of the Competition will be announced at the end of November 2013 on the web page of the Fund "Bošnjaci" Sarajevo – www.fondbosnjaci.co.ba with the right for complaint/appeal within 7 days from the publication of the results.

IX

Awarded scholarships for September, October, November and December of this year will be paid upon signing of the Scholarship Agreement.

NOTICE:

1. The right to participate in the Competition have full time students of the **first cycle** of study at **public** high level education institutions (*universities, faculties and academies*) on Bosnia and Herzegovina territory and full time students of the **second cycles** of the studies with grade point average of **10.00**;
2. Selection of students of the third cycle of studies, from among previous fellows of the Fund "Bošnjaci" with an average grade of 10.00, will be carried out in cooperation with former fellows following a particularly established criteria;
3. Scholars of the Fund "Bošnjaci" **with grade point average 10.00 in the previous year of study** have right for a recognition and award in amount of **150.00 KM**;
4. The most successful scholars of the Fund "Bošnjaci" at the first and second cycles of studies of the University in BiH in academic year 2012/13 have right for a recognition and award in amount of **300.00 KM**;
5. Together with an **application for scholarship (Form:ZFB-1)** submit **original documents** or **certified copies**;

6. An integral part of this Competition is the **System of rating of candidates (Form: SBBZ-1)** published on the web page ***www.fondbosnjaci.co.ba*** so the candidate is required to **perform own rating**.
7. Untimely and incomplete applications **will not be taken into consideration**.
